Dear President Peskin:

At the October 23, 2006 meeting, the West of Twin Peaks Central Council voted to support their member and affiliated organizations, Twin Peaks Improvement Association, MidTown Terrace Homeowner's Association and Forest Knolls Homeowner's Association in their appeal of a Planning Department determination on Sutro Tower.

The Planning Department rendering that the ongoing addition of antenna's on Sutro Tower are categorically exempt from environmental review under the California Environmental Quality Act would be believe should be denied.

The 977-foot Sutro Tower and its ongoing expansion has impacts not just on the surrounding neighborhoods but on others as well. The WTPCC has supported the neighborhoods in the past to urge the City to examine more closely the cumulative impacts of Sutro Tower and the related noise, interference, and other issues.

It is imperative the Board of Supervisors acts so that further analysis and a broader review of the impacts of Sutro Tower can be examined. Please support the appeal on your calendar today.
