Featured Speakers: LHH: Shirley Hansen, about the Civil Grand Jury's conclusions and summaries on the San Francisco pension fund; Jeff Adachi, the San Francisco Public Defender, in support of Proposition B (pension reform); and Tim Paulson, ED of the San Francisco Labor Council, speaking against it.

Meeting called to order: 7:30 pm

Minutes: June 28, 2010 minutes were approved after Dave Bisho moved and Don Dutil seconded. Dave Bisho asked that we dedicate tonight's meeting to the memory of Charlie Meyer, a long and active supporter of the West of Twin Peaks Central Council.

Treasurer's Report: Carolyn Squeri reported that there is \$4192.28 in the treasury.

Committee Reports: Communications & Events, Public Health and Land Use & Planning: no reports; Transportation & Traffic: Avrum Shepard reported that the Better Streets Plan means that changes and more construction will be coming up.

Old Business: George Wooding stated that we are still waiting on the response from the City Attorney regarding an independent audit of the LHH gift fund.

New Business: Karen Breslin spoke against the ballot measure F, stating that it saves too little money. Marisa Rodriguez, ADA, spoke about the possibility of having a liaison at each of our meetings and gave a handout about the standard to arrest.

Featured Speakers: Shirley Hansen presented details regarding the audit last year of the city's pension plan, wherein the rate of pay for public employees has outpaced the cost of living, then gave a handout with the Grand Jury's recommended changes.

Jeff Adachi, SF Public Defender, stated that the current pension plan is not fair, is bankrupting the city and that we should support Prop B, which requires city employees to contribute to their pension plans.

Tim Paulsen, ED of the SF Labor Council, stated that Measure B has nothing to do with pensions (which he says *is* a well-funded plan) and that it is an attack on the health care of public sector employees.

Several questions and comments were then made and George Wooding thanked the speakers.
